Stanley Hupfeld became President and Chief Executive Officer of Integris Health on July 1, 1994. This Health System is an integrated delivery system composed of Integris Baptist Medical Center, Integris Southwest Medical Center, and Integris Rural Health. The System comprises of 16 hospitals, all in Oklahoma. He was previously President and Chief Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Healthcare Corporation and Baptist Medical Center of Oklahoma from 1987 to 1994. Prior to that Mr. Hupfeld served as President of All Saints Healthcare in Fort Worth, TX for ten years. Mr. Hupfeld is currently a member of the Board of Directors of the American Hospital Association and serves as Chairman of the AHA’s Regional Policy Board (7). He has served as a Health Care Systems delegate and alternate delegate and Metro section alternate delegate on the Section for Metropolitan Hospitals Governing Council. He is also Chairman of the Coalition to Project America’s Health Care Board and has served as fund-raising Co-Chair. He has spoken and been published widely, having been honored as the “CEO Marketer of the Year” by the American Society for Healthcare Planning and Marketing, and as “Executive of the Year” by the Sales & Marketing Executives International.


