FACULTY: Curtis E. Harris, MS, MD, JD, FCLM

Dr. Harris is the Chief of Endocrinology for the Chickasaw Indian Nation and Director of the Chickasaw Nation Diabetes Care Center. Prior to his current position, he was in private practice as an Endocrinologist in Oklahoma City, OK for more than 25 years, with a specialty of Diabetology. He has been President of the Oklahoma Chapter of the American Diabetes Association; and in 1998, was the first physician in Oklahoma to receive the American Diabetes Association Physician Excellence Award, with Distinction. In 2004, he was appointed by the Governor of Oklahoma to the Oklahoma Medical Licensure Board, in recognition of his work on improving clinical excellence and quality assurance in Oklahoma. In May, 2007 he was elected to the Board of the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB), which is the oversight organization for the 70 MD and DO state licensure boards in the US.


