The Honorable Judge Noma D. Gurich has been a trial judge for 21 years. After being appointed by Governor Keating she won a county-wide election for District Judge November 1998. She was re-elected without opposition in 2002-2006. Judge Gurich served as the presiding Administrative judge for the Seventh Judicial District, Oklahoma County from January 2003 – December 31, 2004. Prior to her appointment to the bench, Judge Gurich was engaged in the private practice of law in Oklahoma City, OK. She has tried more than 170 jury trials during her career as a District Judge.


