A graduate of New York University, New York Institute of Technology College of Osteopathic Medicine, and Harvard School of Public Health, Dr. Chaudhry completed an internship at St. Barnabas Hospital and an ACGME-accredited residency in Internal Medicine at NYU-Winthrop Hospital, where he was Chief Medical Resident. Dr. Chaudhry was an Assistant Dean and Chair of Medicine at NYITCOM from 2001-2007 and spent 14 years with the United States Air Force Reserve, rising to the rank of Major. He also served as a Flight Surgeon attached to the 732<sup>nd</sup> Airlift Squadron at McGuire Air Force Base. Dr. Chaudhry is the author or co-author of more than 75 peer-reviewed medical journal articles and co-author of two books: *Fundamentals of Clinical Medicine, 4<sup>th</sup> edition* and *Medical Licensure and Discipline in America*.
