



ENROLLMENT INFO FOR PHYSICIANS

Becoming a pandemic provider:

- **The COVID-19 vaccination program is part of a collaboration under the state immunization program's cooperative agreement with the CDC.**
 - Thank you for your interest in becoming a COVID-19 vaccine provider.
 - Any facility, organization, or healthcare provider licensed to possess vaccine, administer vaccine, or provide vaccination services in Oklahoma is eligible to enroll.
 - Only local County and City-County Health Departments and providers enrolled through this online enrollment and approved by the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) can receive and administer COVID-19 vaccines in Oklahoma.
- **Here's how to enroll as a COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider**
 - Step 1: All COVID-19 providers must be able to adhere to the COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider [Requirements](#) and sign a Redistribution Agreement.
 - Step 2: Complete online enrollment [at this link](#).
 - Step 3: OSDH will check the enrollment application and enroll the provider into OSIS and VTrckS.
 - Please submit a separate enrollment for each organization's facility.
 - Do not submit enrollment for each individual healthcare provider
