Due to the outbreak of COVID-19 across the United States, supplies of personal protective equipment (PPE) for hospitals and clinics are dangerously low. The State of Oklahoma has compiled a list of equipment needed for our medical professionals over the next few weeks. We ask that you reach out to the members in your organization to request bulk donations of the following items:

- New face shields
- New goggles
- New CDC/NIOSH approved for medical use N95 Masks/Respirators
- New impervious gowns
- New Tyvek suits
- New procedure and surgical masks
- New hand sanitizer
- New hospital disinfectant
- New infrared thermometers
- New industrial or medical use Powered Air Purifying Respirator (PAPR) ensembles
- New industrial or medical use Powered Air Purifying Respirator (PAPR) hoods, filters, batteries
